I am directed to state that on consideration of the recommendations of the Expert Committee and the concerned Regional Committee, it has been decided by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) to extend approval for the course(s) mentioned at Annexure I for the academic year 2000-2001 with reduced intake.

Your institution has been put under reduced intake category for the academic session 2000-2001, since you have not been able to comply with the minimum norms and standards as stipulated by the Council.

The deficiencies identified by the Council alongwith the norms of the Council are given at Annexure I and II respectively for your kind reference.

You are requested to submit a compliance report on the deficiencies mentioned at Annexure I, if you so desire to the Council, not later than July 31, 2000. Your compliance shall be placed before the Grievance Committee constituted by the Executive Committee of the Council. If required, you shall be called to present your case before this committee and based on the recommendations, decision of the Council in this regard shall be communicated to you.

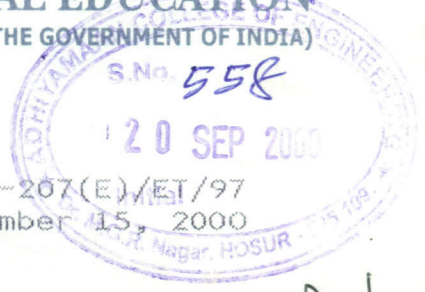

3. These relaxations will be applicable only for the academic year 2000-2001 intake levels. In case your institution is not able to comply within the time stipulated as above, it will lose the benefit of any relaxation given and would be bound by such decisions as the AICTE may take thereafter.
