Subject: Proposal for approval of Adhiyamaan College
of Engineering, Hosur.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this office letter of even No. dated 15th May 1990, on the above subject, and to state that on the recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Southern Regional Committee, the Minister for Human Resource Development, in his capacity as Chairman, All India Council for Technical Education, has approved the re-opening of the Adhiyamaan College of Engineering, Hosur, to admit students in the 1st year of the following degree courses in Engineering during 1991-92 only with the intake capacity as shown against each:-

<u>Degree Course</u>	<u>Present intake capacity</u>
1. Mechanical Engineering	40
2. Electronics & Communication Engineering	40
3. Computer Science & Engg.	40
Total =	120

The above sanction is subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- A. The management should make all efforts to complete construction of buildings by end of April 1992, while constructing the building, norms prescribed


by AICTE for buildings space namely instructional area, administrative area, area for amenities etc should be followed.

- B. The college should procure equipments for the second year before the end of the academic year 1991-92.
- C. Library books and journals should be provided as per norms of AICTE.
- D. The College authorities should take immediate steps to recruit appropriately qualified teaching staff for running the first year B.E. Degree Courses.
- E. The revised AICTE scales of pay must be implemented for the teaching staff of the college.
- F. The college should make admission of students to the first year degree courses only after obtaining affiliation of the Madras University for the year 1991-92 to which the college will be affiliated.
- G. The college authorities should constitute governing council as per the guidelines laid down by the AICTE.
- H. The college should be inspected by a Committee during May 1992 to review the progress made during the previous year and also to assess the facilities created for the second year B.E. Degree Course so that the Committee can make appropriate recommendations for according approval or otherwise of AICTE for the year 1992-93 to the college.
- I. With the present intake strength of 120 students the management will get limited funds as fees from students as per AICTE norms. The management has agreed to provide additional funds to make good deficiency in recurring expenditure as prescribed by the AICTE.
- J. ~~However when the intake strength is enhanced to~~ 180 per annum the management should muster a proportionate additional financial resources.
- K. The management has given an undertaking that they will not only repay the loan from its own resources, but will also provide the recurring expenditure strictly as per AICTE norms. This aspect will be verified by the Expert Committee during its visit.

- L. In case the additional physical facilities to run the college for the 2nd year of the course, to be assessed by the Expert Committee in May 1992, are not provided, then the management should close the college & transfer the students to other institutions.
2. Further details in this behalf may please be obtained from the Southern Regional Committee of the AICTE.
3. I am to request you to take further necessary action to re-open the college, and communicate the progress made in this behalf to the Southern Regional Committee under intimation to the AICTE.

In continuation of this Council's letter of even No. dated 27th April, 1991, I am directed to state that on the recommendations of the Chairman of the Southern Regional Committee, the Minister for Human Resource Development, in his capacity as the Chairman of the All India Council for Technical Education, has permitted to increase the intake in the Adhiyamaan College of Engineering, Hosur to admit students in the First Year of the following Degree Courses in Engineering during 1991-92 only with the revised intake capacity as shown against each:

Degree Courses

Revised Intake Capacity

a) Mechanical Engineering	60
b) Electronics & Communication Engg.	60
c) Computer Science & Engineering	60

2. There is no change in the conditions mentioned from 'A' to 'B' in the AICTE letter referred to above.

3. The above revised intake is further subject to the College getting permission from the University of Madras for increasing the intakes in the 3 courses.
