SUB:-AICTE APPROVAL TO THE ADHIYAMAAN COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AT HOSUR, TAMIL NADU.

Sir,

In continuation of this Council's letter of even no., dated 5-6-1992 and 15-6-1992. I am directed to state that on the basis of the recommendation of an Expert Review Committee of the AICTE, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has given approval to the Adhiyamaan College of Engineering, Hosur, Tamil Nadu for increase in intake from 30 to 60 in each of the following four year Degree Courses during the academic year 1992-93 only.

COURSES

INTAKE

Electrical & Electronics Engineering	60 (Sixty) ✓
Instrumentation & Control Engineering	60 (Sixty) ✓
Production Engineering	60 (Sixty) ✓

The above approval is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- 1) The Management should make arrangements for welding, foundry and smithy shops as recommended by the Expert Review Committee.
- 2) The teaching faculty particularly at senior level should be in position before starting of the classes. Qualified technical supporting staff at the level of workshop instructors should be appointed immediately.
- 3) The fire fighting equipment should be adequately provided in all the laboratories.
- 4) The Institution should not start any new course without prior approval of the AICTE.
- 5) The Institution should not alter the approved intake for any course under any circumstances without prior approval of the AICTE.

- 6) The management including the Governing Council should be constituted and the Chairman of the Council should be appointed as per the guidelines of the AICTE.
- 7) The admissions should be made as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE as adopted by the State Govt. of Tamil Nadu.
- 8) The admissions should be made only after the minimum requisite facilities are created and the affiliating University and the State Government have given permission to start the course.
- 9) The tuition and other fees should be charged as per the rules prescribed by the State Govt. within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. No capitation fees should be charged from the students/ guardian of the students in any form.
- 10) The accounts of the Institution should be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant and will be open for inspection by AICTE or anybody authorized by it.
- 11) The teaching and other staff should be selected according to procedure, qualification and experience prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- 12) The management should strictly follow any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

An Expert Committee of the Southern Regional Committee of the AICTE will visit the Adhivamaan College of Engineering by the end of academic year 1992-93 to verify the fulfilment of conditions prescribed by the AICTE and to recommend continuation of AICTE approval or otherwise.

In the event of non-compliance by the Adhivamaan College of Engineering with regard to guidelines, norms and standards as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time, the AICTE or anybody authorized by it will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval or recognition without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities arising out of such a withdrawal would solely be that of the Adhivamaan College of Engineering.

You are requested to take appropriate action to implement the decision of the AICTE and to communicate the progress made in this regard to the Southern Regional Committee of the AICTE under intimation to this office.

Subject: Approval to Adhiyamaan College of Engineering, Hosur to continue conduct of the existing degree courses in Engineering during 1992-93.

Sir,

In continuation of this Council's letters of even No. dated 27.4.1991 and 30.8.1991, I am to convey AICTE approval to Adhiyamaan College of Engineering to continue conduct of the following three existing degree courses in Engineering during the academic year 1992-93 only with the existing intakes shown against each:

Name of the Degree Course	Duration	Annual Intake
- Mechanical Engineering	4-years	60 (Sixty)
- Electronics & Communication Engineering	4-years	60 (Sixty)
- Computer Science & Engineering	4-years	60 (Sixty)
	Total	180

The above approval is subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- The Management including the Governing Council of the College will be constituted and the Chairman of the Council appointed as the per guidelines of AICTE
- Admission shall be made on merit as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE from time to time and no capitation or donation of any kind shall be charged for admissions.

- (c) The faculty shall be selected on All India basis by open selection according to procedure, qualifications and experience laid down by the AICTE.
- (d) Reservations shall be provided for students and staff as per policy of the State Government applicable from time to time.
- (e) The accounts of the College shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorized by it.
- (f) The College shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
- (g) A Head of Department in each discipline should be appointed before July 1992 and atleast three Asst. Professors for each course should also be appointed by December 1992 as per the qualifications and experience laid down by the AICTE.
- (h) The Civil and Electrical works relating to Devices Laboratory should be completed by June 1992.
- (i) Augmentation as recommended by the Expert Committee for Electronics Laboratory, Network & Control Laboratory and IC Laboratory should be carried out by December 1992.
- (j) The Foundry and Welding shops should be established before June 1992 after augmenting the same as per recommendations of the Expert Committee.
- (k) The Fluid Mechanics & Machinery Laboratory as well as SOM Laboratory should be established by December 1992.
- (l) The appointment orders of the staff should be revised clearly indicating AICTE scales of pay.
- (m) A qualified Store-keeper should be appointed to complete all the stock register of all the laboratories and shops of the College.
- (n) The Computer Laboratory, the Microprocessor Laboratory and the Digital Laboratory should be air-conditioned.
- (o) The College shall follow strictly any further condition as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

The College would be inspected by an AICTE team during April 1993 to review the progress made during the previous year and also to assess the facilities created including appointment of faculty for specialised courses for the 3rd year B.E. Degree course so that the team can make appropriate recommendation for according approval or otherwise for the year 1993-94.

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In the event of non-compliance by the College with the above conditions of the AICTE, the AICTE will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities due to withdrawal of approval would be that of the College.

You are requested to kindly take necessary action in the matter and keep the Southern Regional Committee (SRC) office at Madras, and this Council informed of the progress made in this behalf.
