Sir,

I am directed to state that on the basis of the recommendations of the Expert Committee of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), the AICTE has accorded approval to the Adhiyamaan College of Engineering, Hosur, Tamil Nadu for conduct of the following full-time 4 year degree courses with the annual intake indicated against each during the academic year 1993-94 :-

EXISTING COURSES

Mechanical Engineering	60(sixty)
Computer Science & Engineering	60(sixty)
Electronics & Communication Engineering	60(sixty)
Instrumentation & Control Engineering	60(sixty)
Production Engineering	60(sixty)
Electrical & Electronics Engineering	60(sixty)

ADDITIONAL COURSES

Chemical Engineering	30(thirty)
Civil Engineering	60(Sixty)

The above approval is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions :

1. Immediate steps to be taken to strengthen the library holdings, including national and international journals.
2. The Computer Centre should be shifted to a room with an area of 500 sqm. before starting the academic year 1993-94.
3. The installation process of Smithy, fitting carpentry, welding, moulding, machine shops etc. should be completed immediately.

4. The deficiencies in laboratory equipment (e.g. Kaplan Turbine) pointed out by the Expert Committee during its visit should be rectified immediately.
5. The equipments for the laboratories should be installed for the II<sup>nd</sup> year classes for the following courses before admissions are made for the academic year 1993-94.  
Instrumentation & Control Engineering.  
Production Engineering  
Electrical & Electronics Engineering.
6. The equipments for the laboratories should be installed for the III<sup>rd</sup> year classes for the following courses before admissions are made for the academic year 1993-94.  
Mechanical Engineering.  
Computer Science & Engineering.  
Electronics & Communication Engineering.
7. The faculty and other teaching staff should be paid AICTE pay scales with immediate effect.
8. The recurring cost per student per year should be brought up to the norms of the AICTE i.e. Rs.11,916/-.
9. The new courses should be started only after obtaining the affiliation from the concerned University.
10. The Management of the College including the Governing Council should be constituted as per the guidelines of the AICTE.
11. All admissions should be made as per the norms and standards of the AICTE as adopted by the State of Tamil Nadu in full compliance of the provisions of the SCHEME as prescribed by the Supreme Court of India in its judgement dated 4.2.1993 on WP(C) No.607 of 1992.
12. The tuition and other fees should be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria laid down by the AICTE from time to time. No capitation fees should be charged from the students or guardians of the students in any form.
13. The accounts of the College should be audited by a Chartered Accountant and should be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorized by it.
14. The college should augment the facilities for the existing courses, should not request for starting of additional courses at under graduate level till 1996-97.

15. The approved intakes should not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.
16. The management should strictly follow any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

In the event of non compliance by the Trust or the College the above conditions of the AICTE, the AICTE will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and all the consequent liabilities will solely be that of the University/Institute.

An Expert Committee of the AICTE will visit the College by the end of the academic year 1993-94 to review the progress made in fulfilling the conditions laid down by the AICTE and recommend continuation of the AICTE approval or otherwise.

You are requested to kindly take appropriate action to implement the decision of the AICTE and communicate the progress made in this regard to the Southern Regional Office of the AICTE under intimation to this Office.
