SUB: AICTE APPROVAL TO THE ADHIYAMAAN COLLEGE OF
ENGINEERING, HOSUR, TAMIL NADU FOR CONDUCT OF FULL-TIME
AND PART-TIME MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA)
PROGRAMMES

Sir,

I am directed to state that on the basis of the recommendations of the All India Board of Management Studies of the Statutory AICTE, the All India Council for Technical Education has accorded approval to the Adhiyamaan College of Engineering, Hosur, Tamil Nadu for conduct of full-time and part-time MBA Courses with an annual initial intake of 40 each during the academic year 1992-93 only.

The above approval is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions.

- 1) Separate premises with adequate facilities should be established by the end of the academic year 1992-93 with an exclusive identity for the Department of Management Studies.
- 2) The Management of the College including the Governing body should be constituted as per the guidelines of the AICTE.
- 3) The admissions should be made as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE as adopted by the State Government of Tamil Nadu.
- 4) The admissions to the courses should be made only after the requisite facilities are created and the affiliating University has given permission to start the courses.
- 5) The tuition and other fees should be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria laid down by the AICTE from time to time. No capitation fees should be charged from the students or guardians of the students in any form.

- 6) The Accounts of the Institute should be audited by the Chartered Accountant and should be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
- 7) Teaching and other staff should be recruited according to the procedure guidelines and experience prescribed by the AICTE and the faculty should be paid the AICTE pay scales.
- 8) No new course should be started in or by the College without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- 9) The approved intakes should not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- 10) The Management should strictly follow any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time

In the event of non-compliance by the Trust or the College with the above conditions of the AICTE, the AICTE will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all the consequent liabilities will solely be that of the Institute.

An Expert Committee of the All India Board of Management Studies of the AICTE will visit the College by the end of academic year of 1992-93 to review the facilities of the Institute and consider the increase in the intake from 40 to 60 for the Full-time and Part-Time MBA courses for the academic year 1993-94 and make recommendations to AICTE for approval or otherwise.

You are requested to kindly take appropriate action to implement the decision of the AICTE and communicate the progress made in this regard to the Southern Regional Office and the AICTE Delhi.
