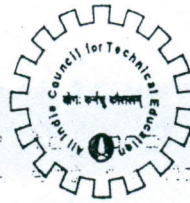

Sir,

You might recall that you had visited this institution on 10th May, 1992. On the basis of the recommendations made by you, the AICTE had accorded approval on 2nd June, 1992 to the Institute for conduct of above mentioned courses with an intake of 40 (forty) each for one year during 1992-93 only subject to fulfilment of certain conditions. A copy of your report and our approval letter dated 2nd June, 1992 is enclosed for your kind perusal. In our approval letter, we had also indicated that a visit of the Expert Committee to the Institute would be arranged to decide the extension of approval of AICTE for the year 1993-94 onwards.

The Chairperson, All-India Board of Management Studies has constituted a one-man committee consisting of yourself to make a visit to the institute and make available your recommendations to decide further approval of AICTE to the courses of the Institute from 1993-94 onwards. I am, therefore, to request you to kindly make a visit to the institute in this month i.e. May, 1993 itself and send your recommendations in the form of a report for further necessary action. TA/DA for the purpose of this visit will be paid by AICTE as per rules.

We have already requested the institution on 23rd March, 1993 to send us a 'Compliance report' giving itemwise position of the fulfilment of the conditions as laid down in our approval letter. We have so far not received the same. We are advising

the institution to send a copy of the 'Compliance report' to you directly with a copy each to the AICTE Secretariat and the SRO, Madras.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your kind attention to our letter of even number dated 2nd June, 1992 addressed to the Secretary, Education Department, Government of Tamilnadu, Madras and copy inter-alia endorsed to you on the subject mentioned above and to request you to kindly send "Compliance Report" giving the itemwise position of the fulfilment of the conditions as laid down therein so that the visit of an Expert Committee could be arranged to the Institute for verifying the facilities created in fulfilment of the conditions and to decide the extension of the AICTE approval for the continuance of the two MBA programmes from the academic year 1993-94 onwards.

In addition to the above, the following letters should also be sent to us for our record and necessary action:-

1. A letter from the Executive Authority of the College stating that they would not cause or allow discontinuance of the Post-graduate courses in Management or alterations in the associated intake of students without the prior concurrence of the AICTE.
2. The undertaking submitted does not include para 5 as per our Model undertaking (copy enclosed). A letter of consent to comply with that condition may be sent to us for our record.
3. In view of the recent Supreme Court Judgement dated 4th February, 1993, kindly confirm through a letter that the courses conducted would definitely be continued, if approved, and that the Management and the College would fully comply with the "SCHEME" as announced in the Supreme Court Judgements and all such procedures, guidelines, criteria, norms etc. etc. as may be laid

down by the AICTE and the State Government for implementation of the said "SCHEME".

Sub: Extension of AICTE approval to the Adhivamaan College of Engineering, Hosur, Tamilnadu for conducting full-time and part-time MBA courses during the year 1993-94.

Sir,

I am directed to state that on consideration of the observations and recommendations of the Expert Committee of the All India Board of Management Studies which visited the college on 26th May, 1993 and further recommendations made by the Chairperson, All India Board of Management Studies, the All India Council for Technical Education has accorded approval for extension of its earlier approval to the Adhivamaan College of Engineering, Hosur, Tamilnadu for conduct of full-time and part-time MBA Courses with an annual intake of 40 each during the academic year 1993-94 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

1. There should be a separate Governing Council for the MBA programme. It will be constituted and the Chairman appointed as per the guidelines laid down/prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
2. The infrastructural, instructional and other facilities including teaching staff, equipment etc. should be provided as per AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
3. An independent building with required space as per AICTE norms should be provided exclusively for conducting the MBA programme. Separate rooms for faculty and smaller rooms for elective courses should be provided before the start of the Second Year of the programme.
4. An independent library should be established for the MBA Programme with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) etc as per AICTE norms.
5. A separate computer Centre with adequate number of PCs, Printers etc. should be established for the MBA Programme.
6. No new course shall be started and no alteration in the approved intake of students in the MBA programme will be made without the prior approval of the AICTE.
7. The teaching faculty should be given pay-scales as per the USC/AICTE guidelines prescribed from time to time.
8. The admissions shall be made as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE/ Govt. of India by the Competent Authority, namely, the State Govt./ University concerned as the case may be.

9. The Faculty/teaching staff should be recruited on All-India basis by open selection as per procedure, qualifications and experience etc. prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State based selections would be permissible for such posts for which the State Government prescribes "State-based Selection" as a general policy.
10. That tuition and other fees will be charged as prescribed by the State Govt. within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
11. No Capitation fee or donation shall be charged from the Students/guardians of the students in any form.
12. A separate account shall be maintained for the MBA programme and the same shall be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or Board or person authorised by it.
13. The teaching and other staff should be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience(s) prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
14. The Management shall strictly follow any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
15. An Endowment Fund of Rs.10 lakhs should be created exclusively for the MBA programme and fixed deposit receipt should be in the combined name of the College and the Director of Technical Education, Govt. of Tamilnadu, Madras.
16. The College by virtue of the approval given by AICTE shall not automatically become claimant to any financial grant or assistance from the Central or State Government.


This approval is further subject to full-compliance with the "SCHEME" as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its judgement dated 4.4.93 with regard to WP(c) No. 607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishnan, J.P. and others etc. etc. vs. State of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and the related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by the AICTE, UGC or the Central Government from time to time.

In the event of non-compliance by the Management/ College with regard to guidelines, norms and conditions laid/prescribed by AICTE from time to time, the AICTE or a body or person authorised by it will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities arising out of such a withdrawal would solely be that of the Management/ College.

In the event of closure of the MBA programmes in Adhiyamaan College of Engineering, Hosur for non-fulfilment of the conditions laid down by the AICTE in future, the State Govt. of Tamilnadu will place the students of the MBA programmes in the above college in other approved management institutions/University Departments of Management within the state.

You are requested to kindly take necessary action in the matter and keep the SRC, Madras and this office informed of the progress made in this regard.

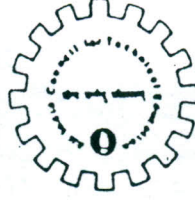
