

Report of the Inspection Commission constituted to  
consider to increase the number of seats in I year  
B.E. Degree course from 120 to 180 for the Academic  
year 91-92 in the

Adhiyamaan College of Engineering, Hosur.

The committee inspected the college on 26th Sep.91. The committee was given a report of the facilities available currently in the college and also a copy of the previous report of the University Commission date 11th July 91.

The committee verified the facilities with reference to the earlier report and found them in order. In addition extra building space has been created.

The committee found that additional staff members have been recruited and met all the staff members except the Principal who was reported to be on leave.

The committee found that equipments required for the second year course are also available.

The committee recommends that the University may approve the increase of strenght from 120 to 180 in the I year B.E. Degree course for the 91-92 (20 additional seats for each branch).
