In his speech he gave a brief idea about pedagogy methods also he added some useful tips about the psychological characters of students in online classes. The invited Resource person Dr. Jayakumar, Former Registrar, Bharathiyar University Gave a detailed presentation on Blooms Taxonomy. In his presentation he explained about “How Bloom’s Taxonomy can aid in course design and How Bloom’s works with course level and lesson level outcomes”

He demonstrated some useful Steps towards writing effective learning outcomes. He also added that there is one measurable verb in each objective and each outcome needs one verb. Either a student can master the outcome, or they fail to master it. If an outcome has two verbs (say, define and apply), what happens if a student can define, but not apply? Are they demonstrating mastery? On his talk he discussed to Ensure that the verbs in the course level outcome are at least at the highest Bloom’s Taxonomy as the highest lesson level outcomes that support it After that questions and interaction session was held in which teachers also shared the information and their doubts were clarified.
